INITIATIVE UPDATE

Summer Pass for Youth

A letter requesting a Summer Youth Transit Pass from Janet Gasparini, Chair, Mayor and Council's Roundtable on Children and Youth was distributed at the meeting.

A Summer Youth Transit Pass Survey of other Municipalities was distributed at the meeting.

The Committee agreed that Transit staff work with the Mayor and Council's Roundtable on Children and Youth to develop a budget option to be implemented in the summer of 2009. They offered 600 5-ride cards to the Roundtable for distribution in the community to assist in deferring the cost of public transportation to youth.

The General Manager of Growth & Development will provide a response to Janet Gasparini, Chair of Mayor and Council's Roundtable on Children and Youth.

Budget Impact - Cost for Fuel

A comparison report on Fuel Consumption and Fuel Cost was distributed at the meeting.

The Director of Transit informed the Committee that a variance report will be presented to City Council at their next meeting. He stated that Transit Services fuel consumption by volume is consistent with previous years, however the cost of fuel has increased resulting in a budget variance.

Stop Announcements

The Manager of Growth & Development stated a plan to comply with the Human Rights Commission (HRC) New Stop Announcements Initiative is being prepared. The preliminary quote for an Automated & Visual Announcement of Stops is \$500,000.

The Manager of Growth & Development informed the Committee a letter would be forwarded to the HRC showing the initial steps for implementing Stop Announcements.

INITIATIVE UPDATE CONT'D

Transit Service to Chelmsford	Councillor Berthiaume advised that he has received calls regarding delays and missed connections with the TransCab service in Chelmsford.
	The Director of Transit stated that two buses are dispensed to Chelmsford/Azilda at peak hours, one being an outbound from Sudbury and the other being an inbound directly to Chelmsford.
	The Manager of Transit Operations stated they have been working with the TransCab Operator to ensure connections are being made. In the event that a scheduled connection is missed, the Transcab Operator is to contact Transit Services in attempt to make the connection or bring the passenger(s) to the Transit Centre, Downtown Sudbury.
Transit Service to Lively	The Director of Transit explained that there is a gap in the Lively service during daytime hours. Service is being expanded during the peak times and options will be looked at to fill the gap.
